New 48-inch Water Transmission Main Construction Notification Letter
Location: Westbound Schoolcraft Road (Middlebelt Road to Inkster Road)

Dear Livonia Business/Resident,

The Great Lakes Water Authority (GLWA) is committed to being the service provider of choice for water of unquestionable quality in southeast Michigan. In keeping with this commitment, GLWA is constantly working to ensure the sustainability of the region's water distribution and transmission system.

As a part of our focus on sustainability, GLWA will be installing a new 48-inch water transmission main along Westbound Schoolcraft Road in Livonia, Michigan, which will ultimately improve service reliability in the area.

The project will start near Middlebelt Road and continue east along westbound Schoolcraft Road ending at Beech Daly Road in Redford Township. GLWA expects the duration of the entire construction project to be from June 2020 through January 2022 with the portion in Livonia lasting approximately 11 months. As a part of the project, GLWA will also be replacing the full width of the existing concrete pavement along Westbound Schoolcraft service drive and restoring areas disturbed by construction activities in partnership with the City of Livonia.

Due to the large scope of this project, work will be done in phases and will require closures on Westbound Schoolcraft Road. Please be assured that GLWA's contractor will provide proper notice of these closures to impacted residents and businesses along the alignment. During construction phases, traffic will be maintained and detoured around the work zone. Local thru traffic will be provided to public and private developments for the entirety of the project. Additionally, if construction is not occurring traffic will be maintained uninterrupted. A project map including the 48-inch water transmission main and primary detour route is included as an attachment to this letter.

We thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding during this project. While there will be some short-term inconveniences, there will be significant long-term benefit to the region from the improvements to the water distribution system, as well as the local roads.

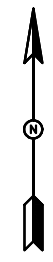

STAGE-1 MERRIMAN TO MIDDLEBELT RD

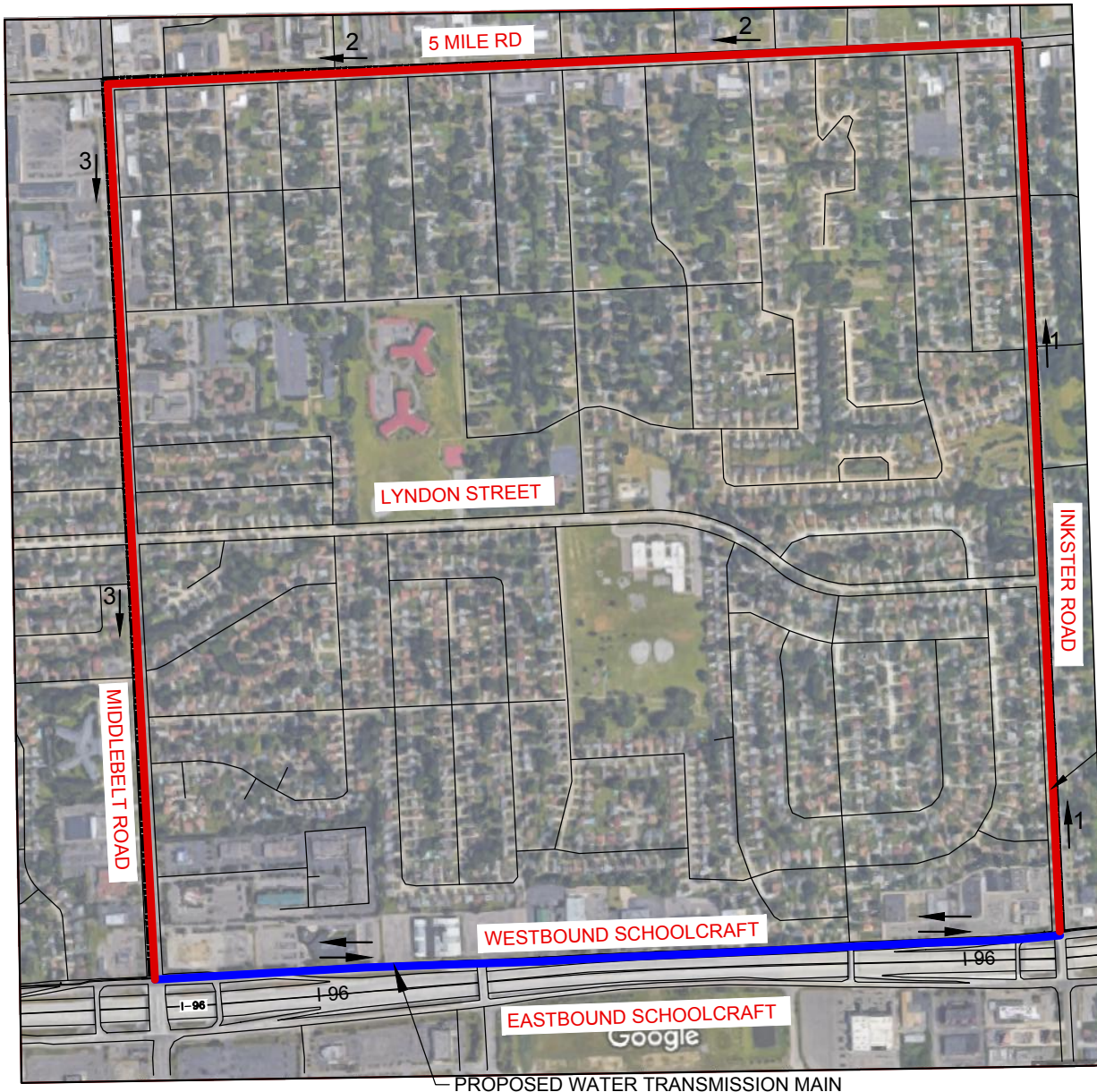
