



Situational Awareness

- Wayne County announces 8 new Livonia residents have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 24 hours. In the last seven days, 76 Livonia residents have tested positive.
- The State of Michigan announces 2,171 new individuals have tested positive for COVID-19 in cases reported to the state in the last 24 hours.
- A panel with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has approved the Pfizer vaccine for emergency use authorization in vaccinations of those ages 12-15. In a press conference, Gov. Gretchen Whitmer said the state is “ready to go” in allowing providers to administer the vaccine to those in this newly eligible age group.
- In Wayne County, 58.5% of adults have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine, compared to 55.4% of adults statewide. Two weeks after the State hits 60% bars, gyms, conference centers and sports stadiums will be able to increase their capacity.
- As of May 10, St. Mary Mercy Hospital is treating 33 patients for COVID-19.
- Michigan residents who have been financially impacted by COVID-19 will be able to receive financial help to pay for home internet as part of the Emergency Broadband Benefit program. For more information, visit the program’s [website](#).
- In the coming weeks, ride-sharing services Uber and Lyft will offer free rides to those going to a vaccination site through July 4.

Actions Taken

- The City of Livonia has updated VaccinateLivonia.org, a hub for information about COVID-19 vaccine appointments in our area. Currently, 24 pharmacies in Livonia are providers of COVID-19 vaccines.
