Situational Awareness

- Wayne County announces zero additional Livonia residents tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 24 hours. In the last seven days, nine Livonia residents have tested positive.
- The State of Michigan announces 179 new individuals have tested positive for COVID-19 in cases reported to the state in the last 24 hours. Michigan reported that just 1.1% of nearly 17,000 COVID-19 tests came back positive in the last day, the lowest rate since the pandemic began.
- Statewide, 417 individuals are hospitalized with confirmed COVID-19 diagnoses. Of that total, 146 are in intensive care units. St. Mary Mercy Hospital is currently treating six patients for COVID-19.
- In non-Detroit Wayne County, 62.4% of residents age 12 or above have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. Statewide, 55.4% of residents in that group have received at least one dose.
- The Wayne County Health Department can provide residents with a replacement COVID-19 vaccination card if the original has been lost or destroyed. A resident may request a replacement card by calling (734) 727-7100.
- The nationwide death toll from COVID-19 has now passed 600,000, according to researchers at Johns Hopkins University.
