The Case Search application **will not** display whether a case is in warrant status, i.e. an arrest warrant was issued. If you think your case may be in a warrant status you should contact the court at 734-466-2500, Monday-Friday, 8:30 am-4:30 pm. Individuals with cases in a warrant status may “walk-in” Monday-Friday at 9 am. The warrant will be recalled, and you will go in the courtroom to speak to the magistrate or judge. You may be required to post a cash bond, so you should come prepared to do so.

The Case Search application **will not** display information on non-public cases. There are three categories of cases where information about the defendant and their cases will not be available to the public: those limited by statute, court order, or court rule. The court cannot acknowledge those types of records except to authorized persons or agencies, therefore you will not be provided any information about a non-public record case over the phone or through the mail.

Tips for Searching

Party Name Search Hints

Search by party name to locate the court docket sheet for a specific party name. The party name can be the name of the individual or organization. Click the “submit” button to begin the search.

When searching by name use the Last Name First Name format. There is no need for commas and only one space separating the Last Name from the First Name. (For example, Smith John). If a middle name appears in the Court's database, it must be included in the search field to generate full and accurate results.

For organization, enter the name of the organization. (For example: ABC Inc.)

Search by Docket Number

Use the By Docket Number Search to locate the court docket sheet for a specific docket number. The docket number is also known as the case number.

Enter the docket or case number and click the "submit" button to begin the search.

Once the search is complete, the docket sheet for that docket number will be displayed.
